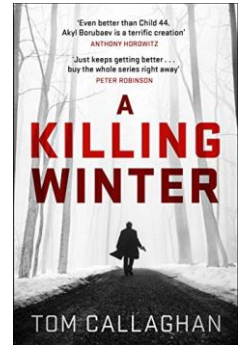
Callaghan, Tom:

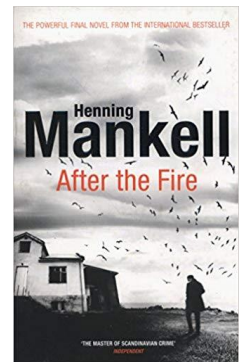
Mankell, Henning:

Tackling love, loss and loneliness, After the Fire is Henning Mankell's compelling last novel.



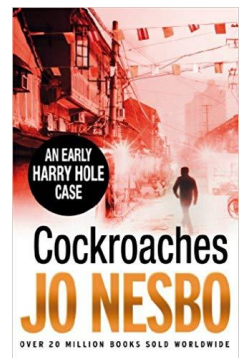

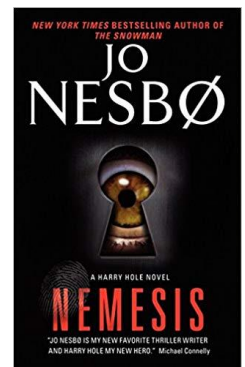

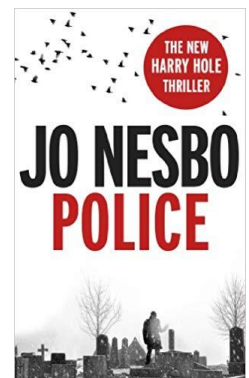

Obama, Michelle:

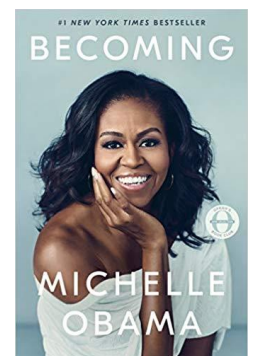

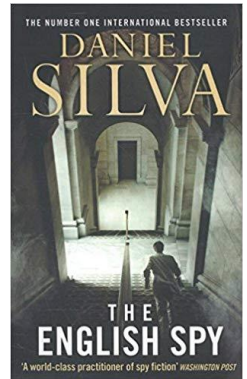
